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Fall Census DSPS Headcount by Highest Level of Education



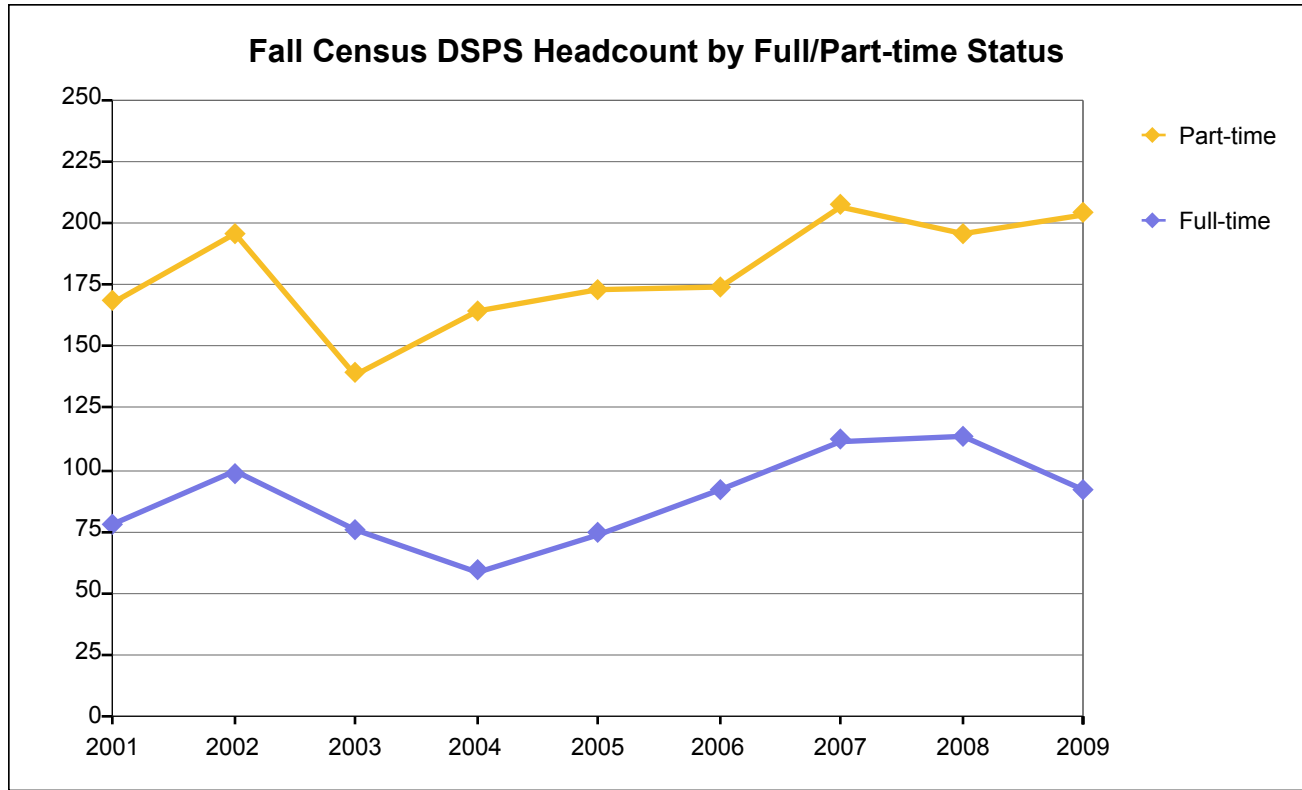

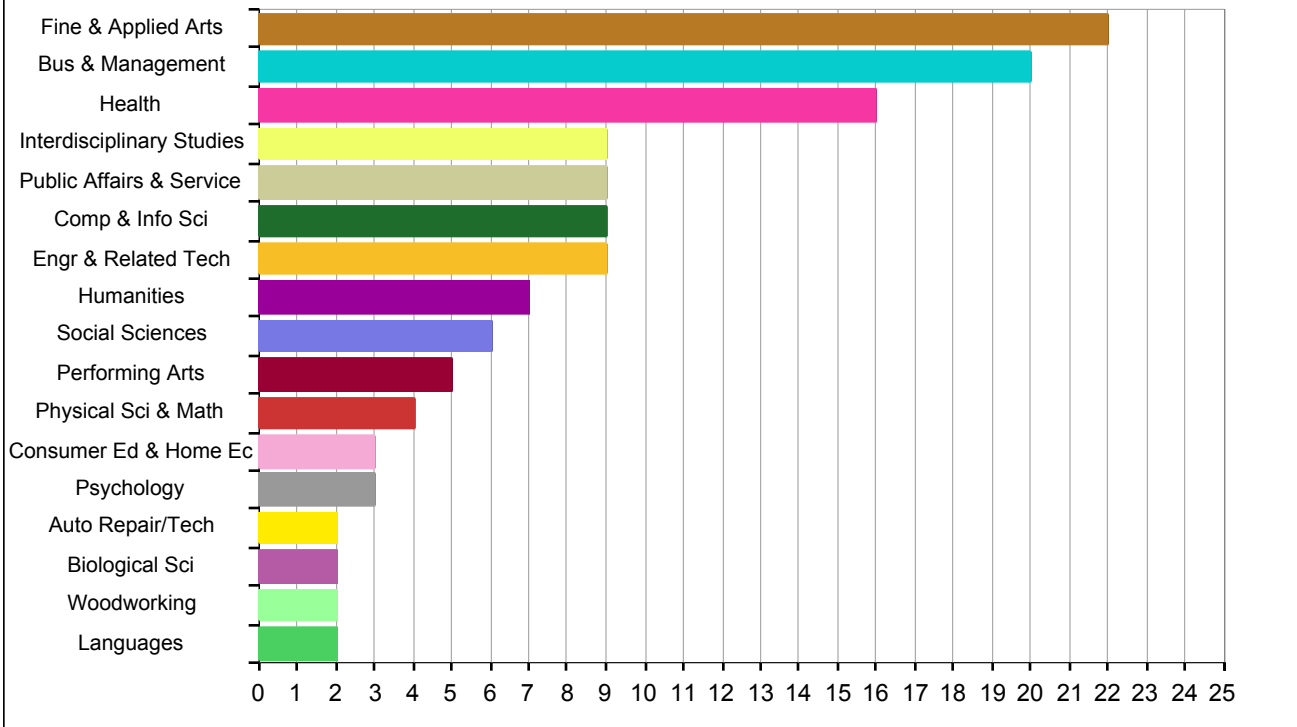

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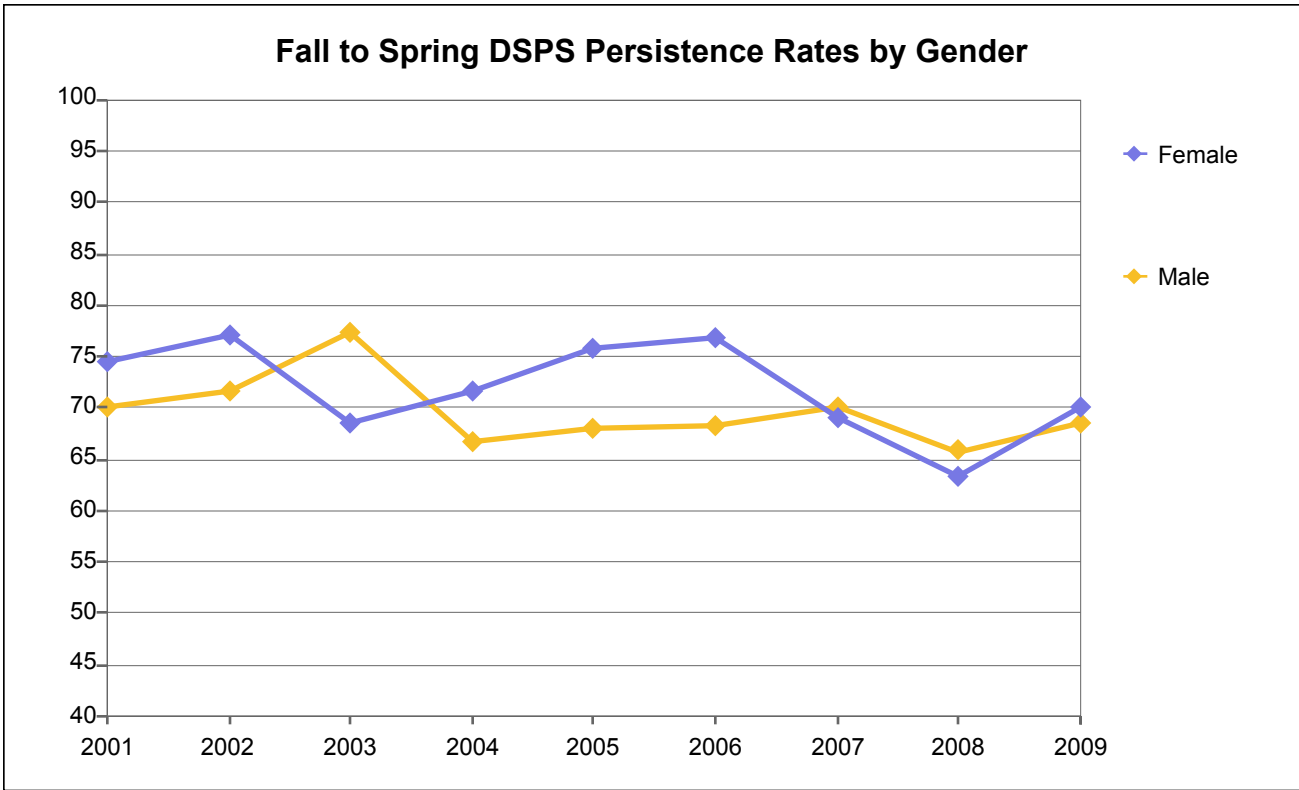
Fall 2009 Census EOPS Headcount by Selected Major Areas
