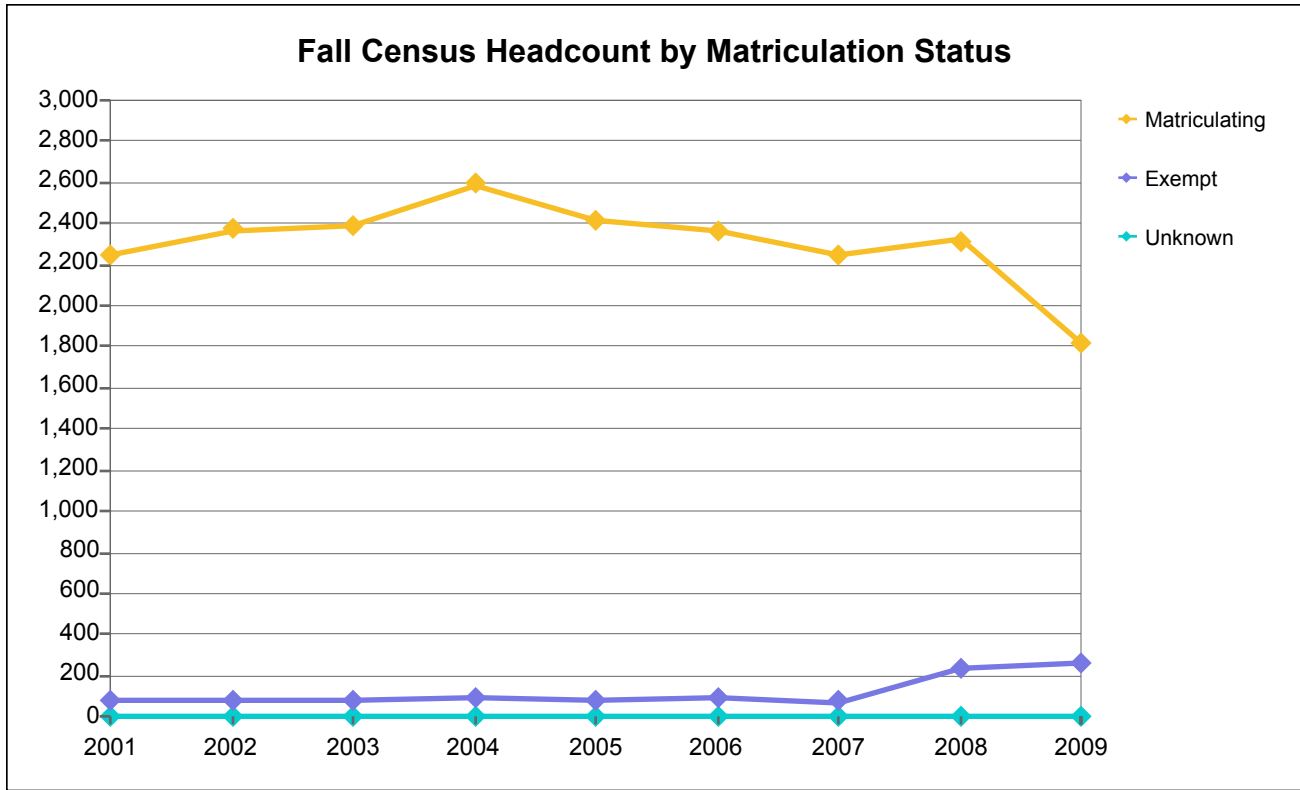

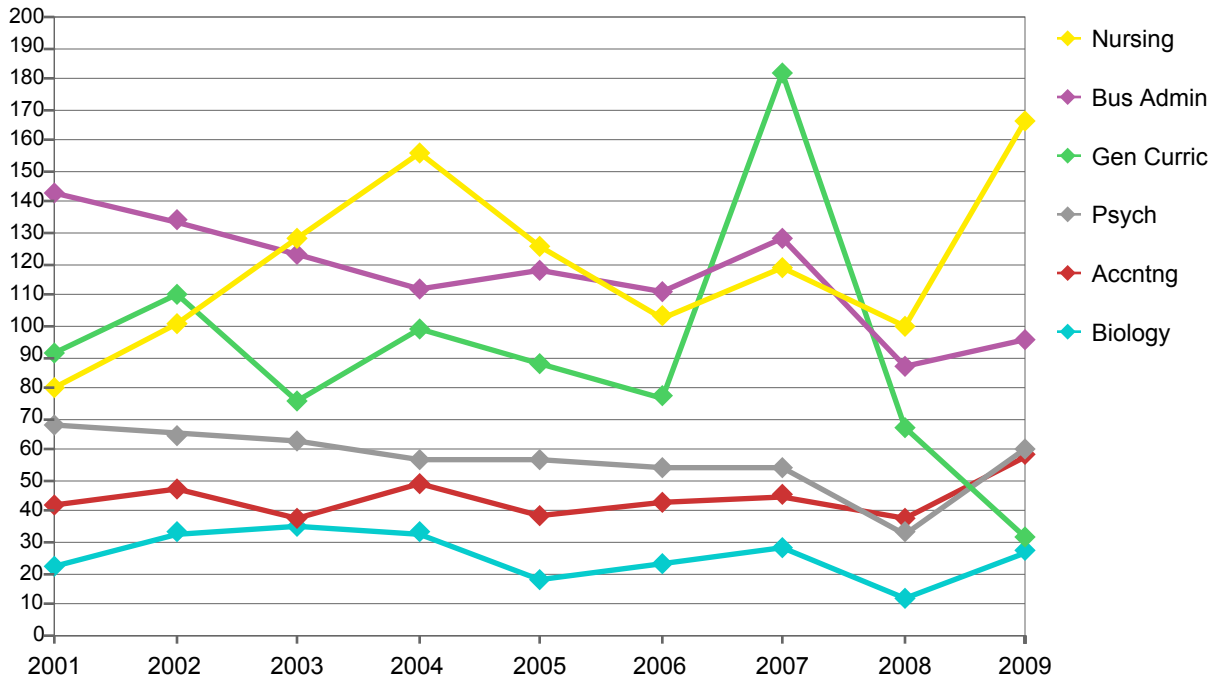

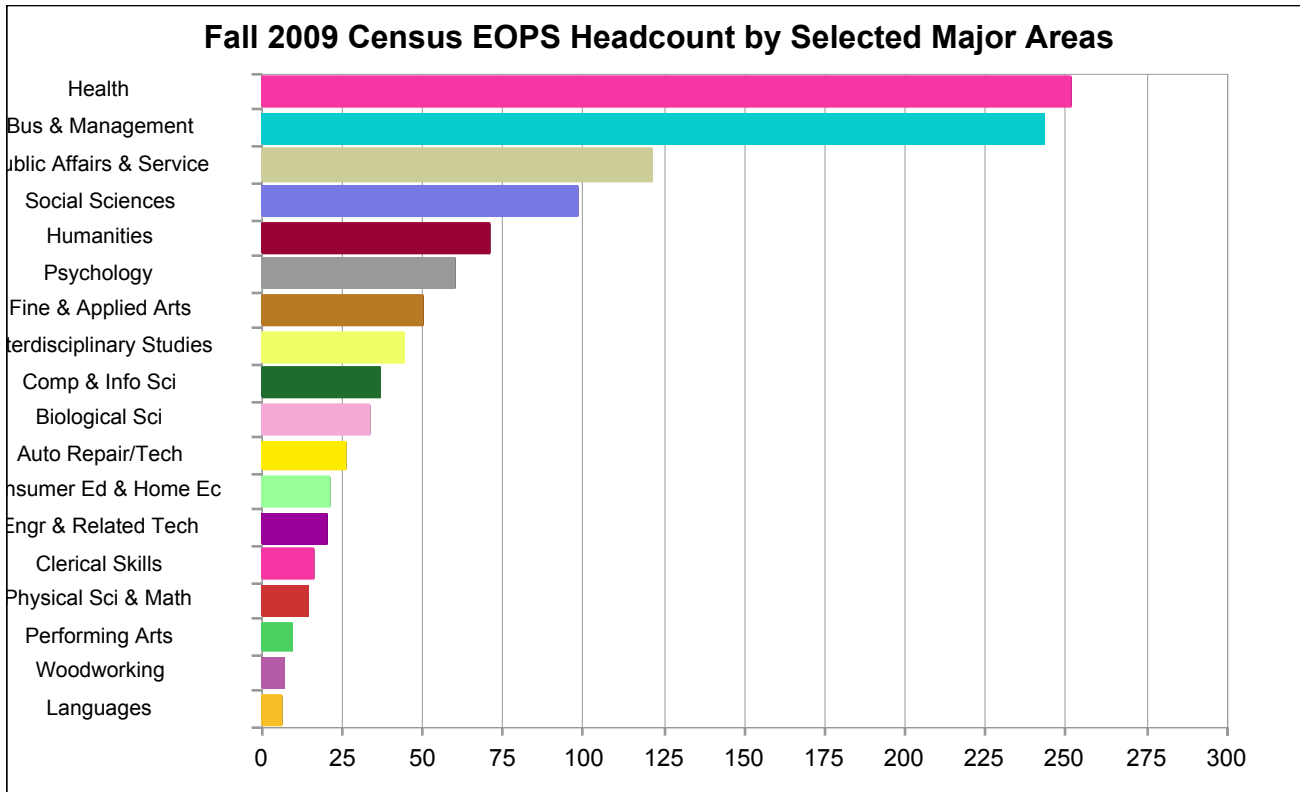

Fall Census DSPS Headcount by Highest Level of Education



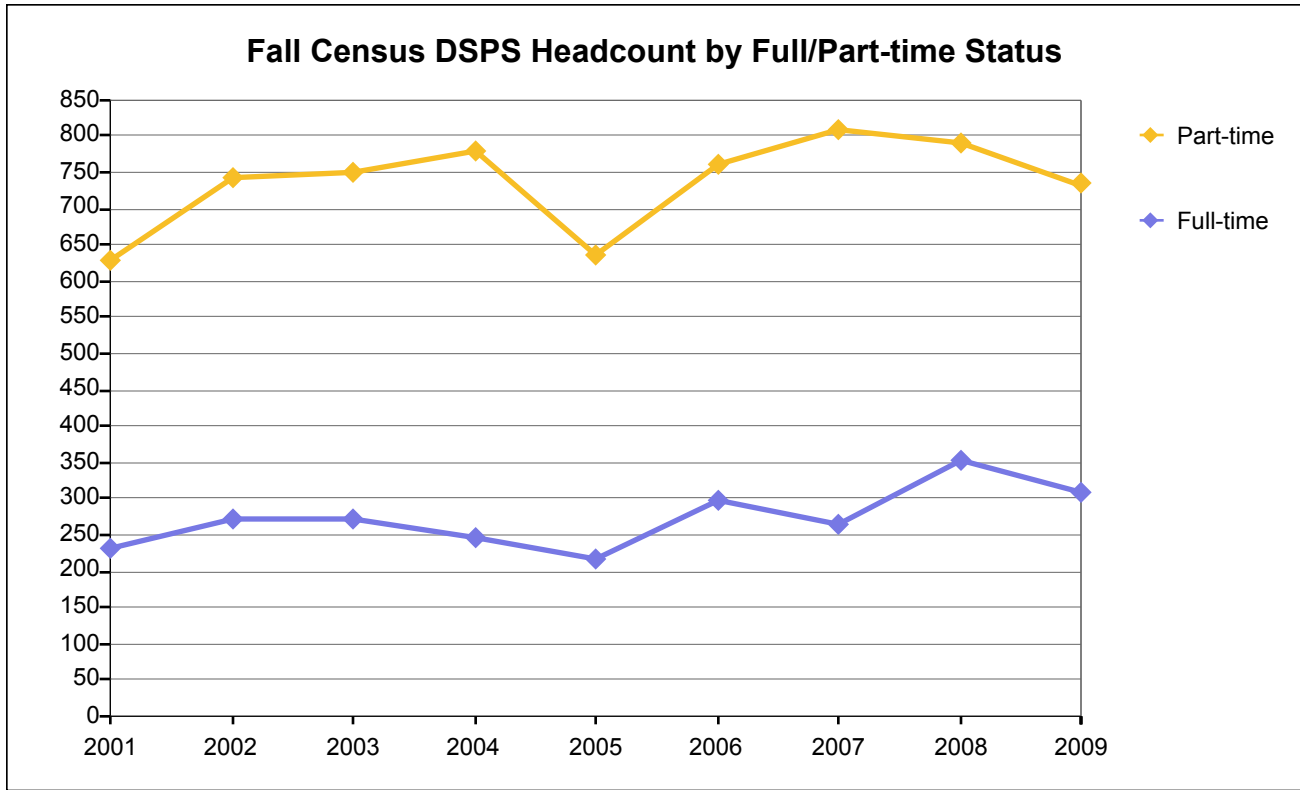

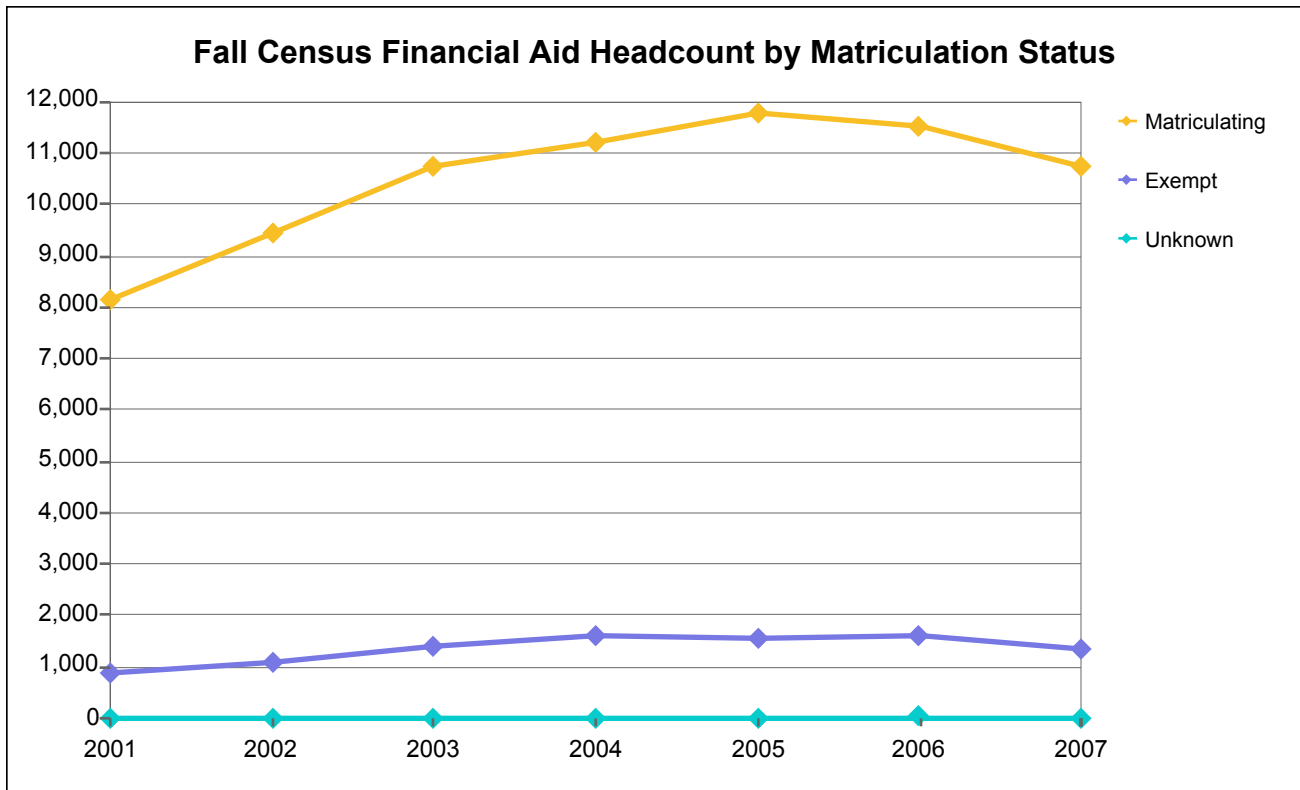

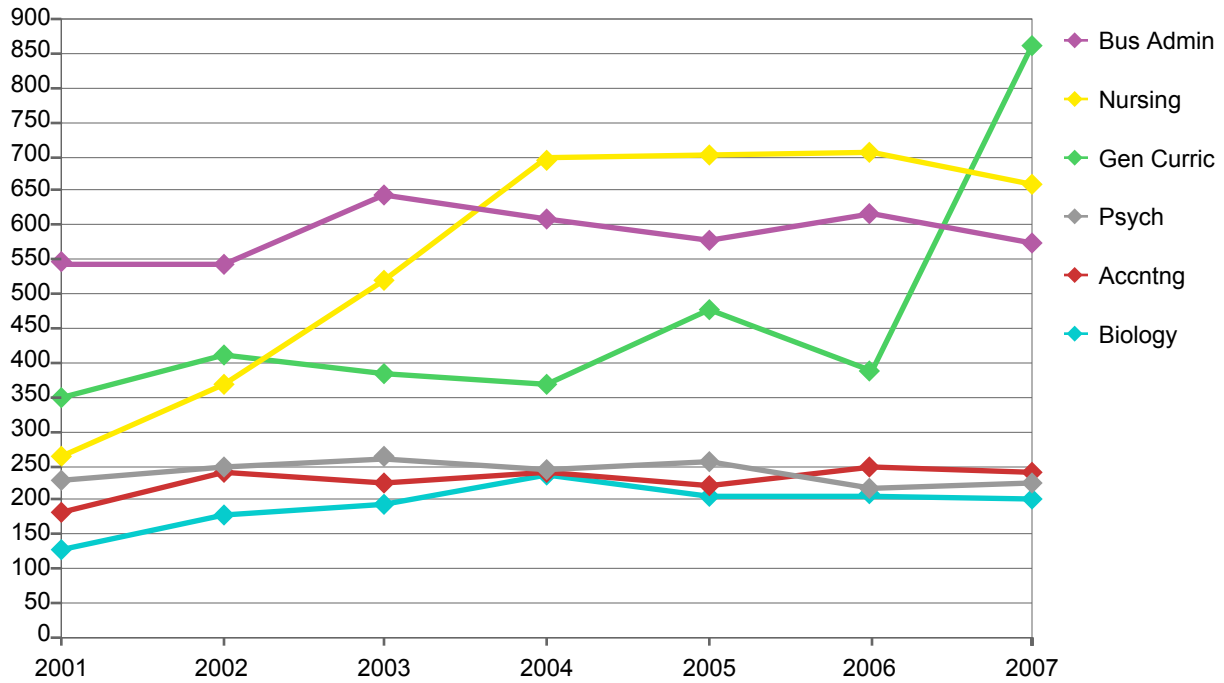

Fall Census Financial Aid Headcount by Seven Most Declared Matriculation Majors



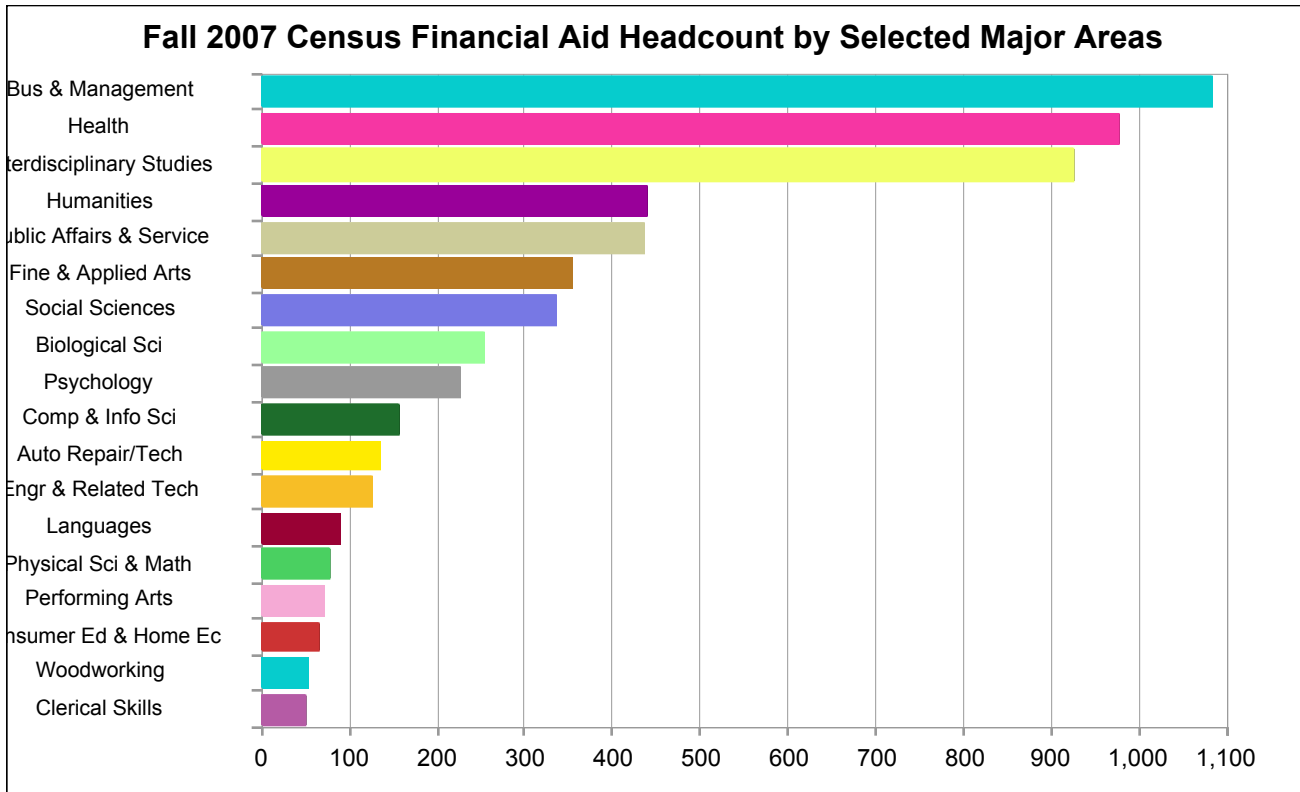
