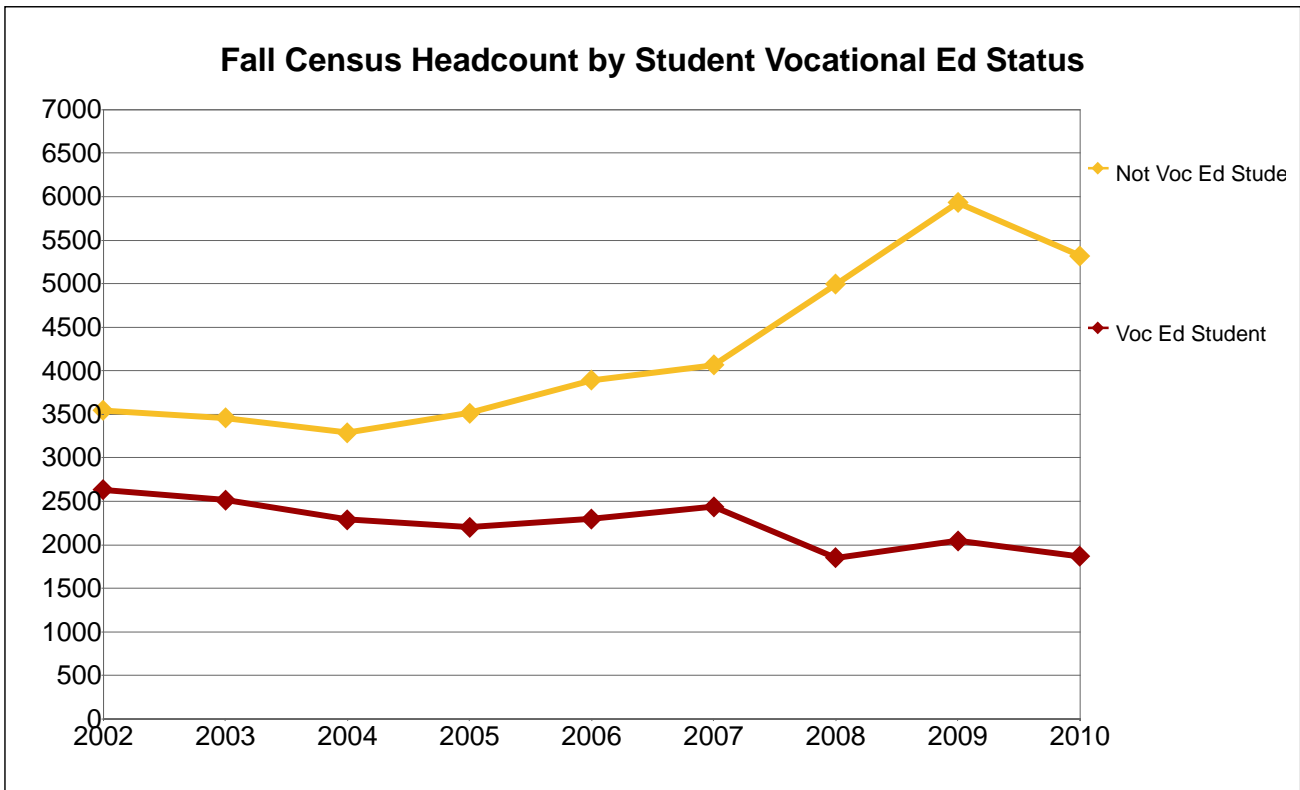

Fall Census Headcount by Student Vocational Education Status

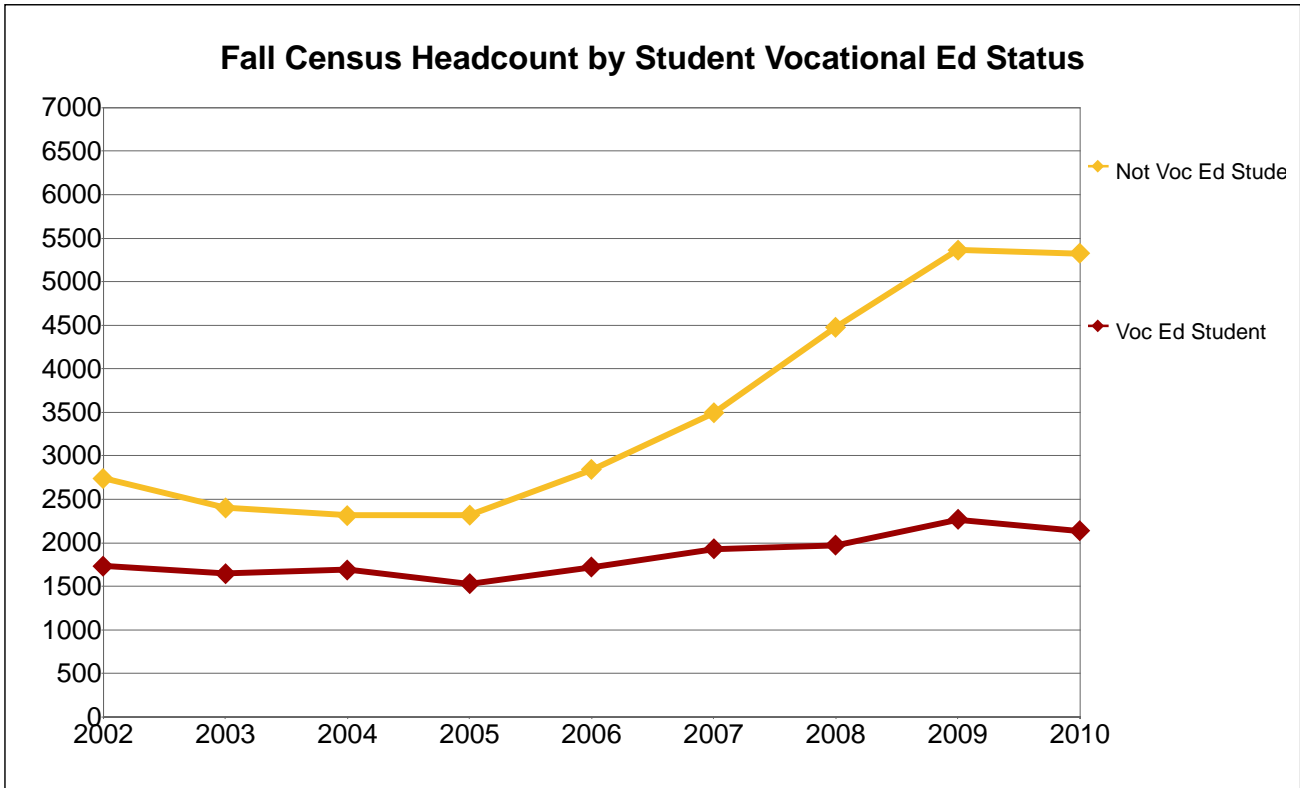

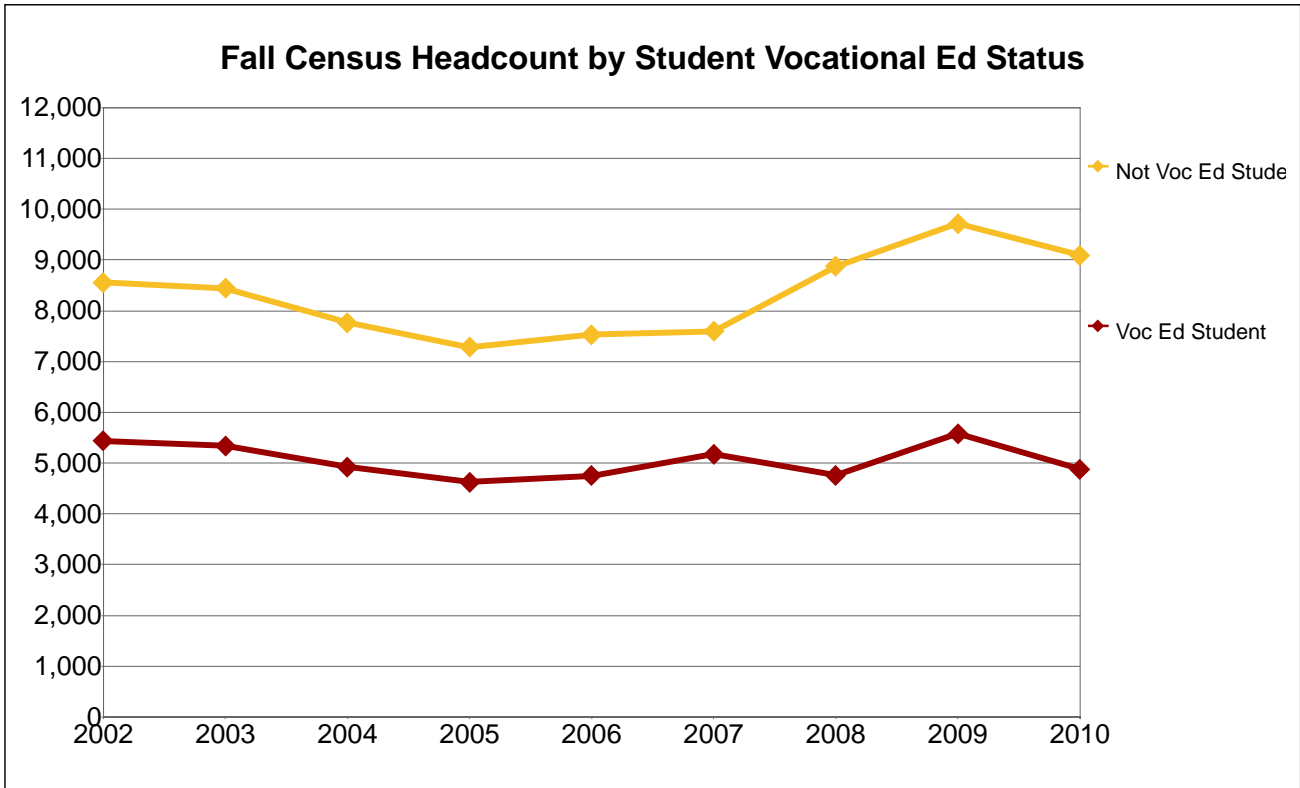

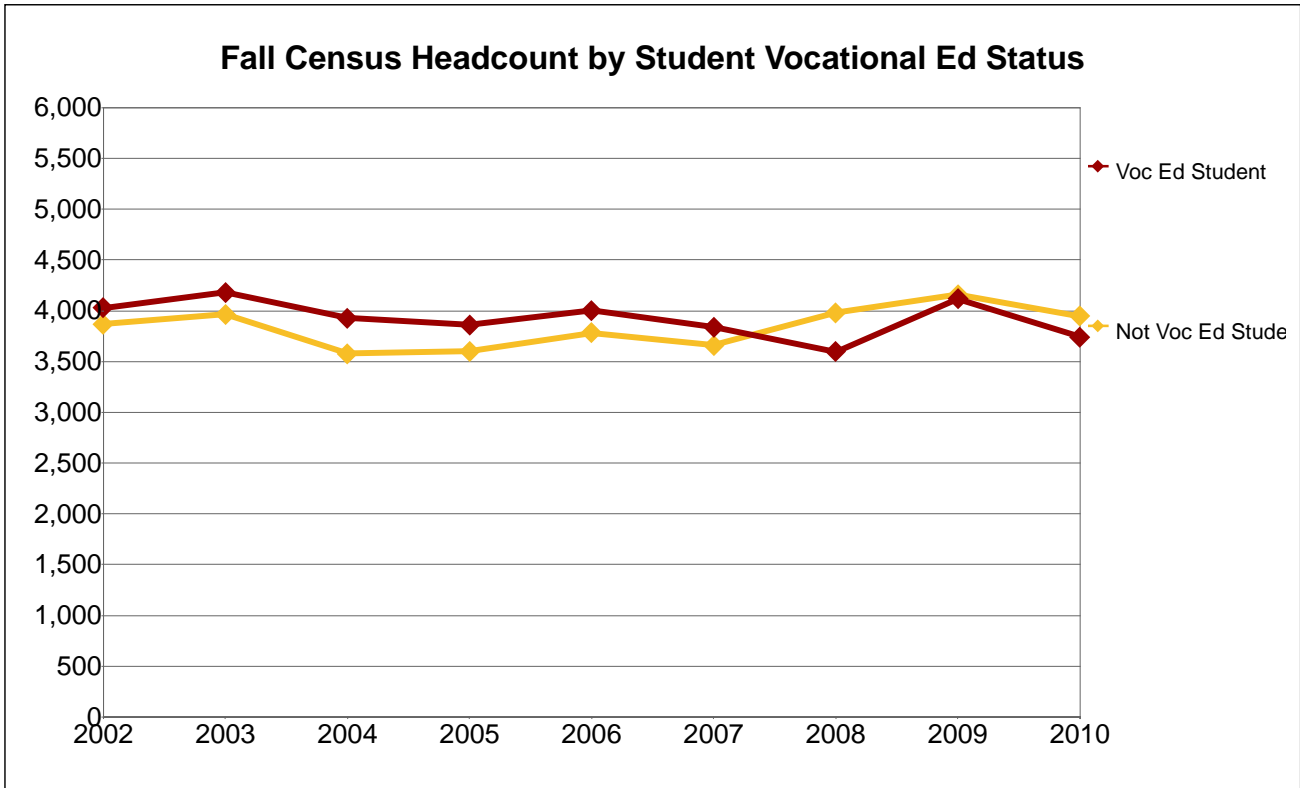

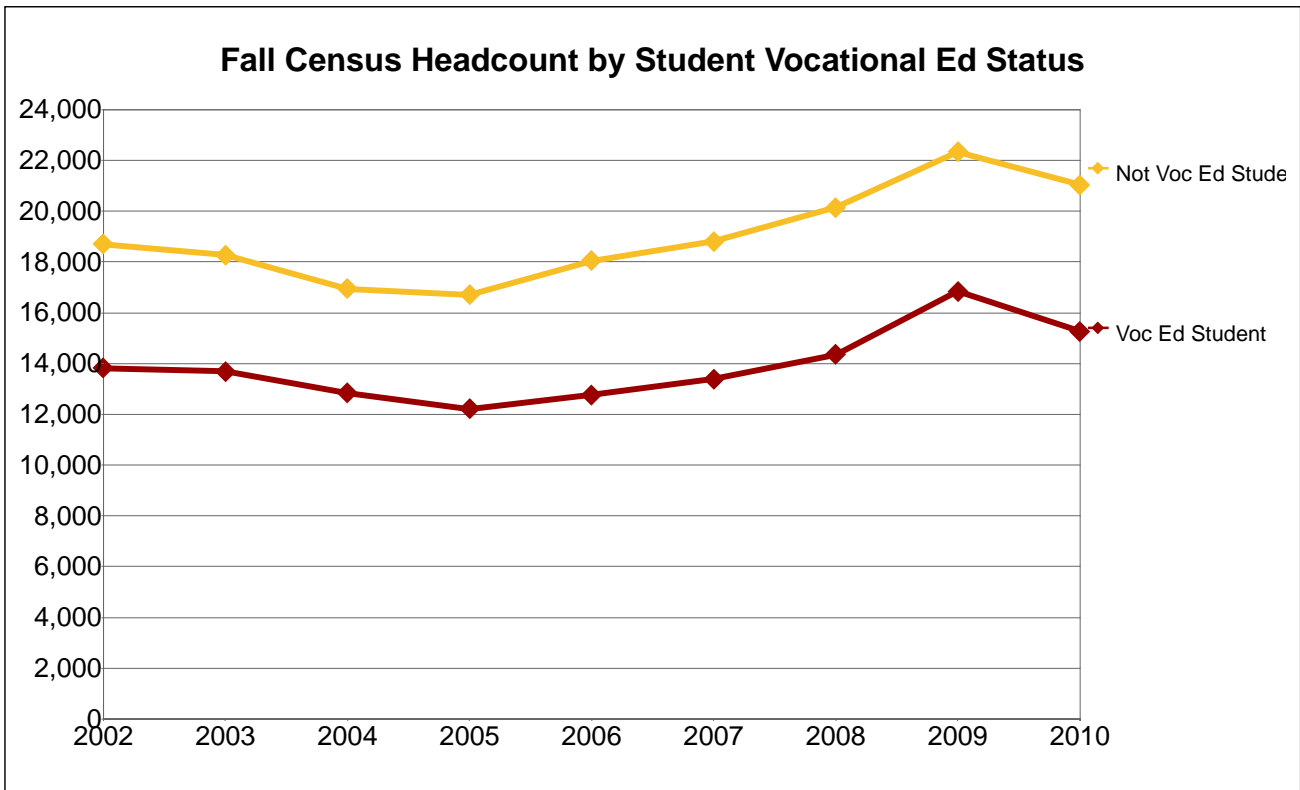
