It is one of the world's leading financial centers and has the fifth-or sixth-largest metropolitan area GDP in the world depending on measurement. It stands 443 feet high on the South Bank of the River Thames. The wheel carries 32 passenger capsules and rotates at a rate of 0.26 meters per second (0.6 mph) so that one revolution takes about 30 minutes to complete.	London
