[20151218-01]	<p>Question – Drawing # SE1.L01b: The three (3) intercoms shown on Drawing SE1.L01b appear to be greater than 1,500 feet from the remote battery backup PoE network switch in the Laney Art Center. This exceeds the maximum distance limitation of the PoE extenders. Should the drawing be modified to show another remote PoE switch at the Laney Child Care Center or Sports Complex?</p> <p>Answer – If required, yes. These drawings have not been engineered. A finite number of locations were chosen so all bids would be equal. The locations indicated on the drawings are suggestions only. If better locations are found once a field survey has been conducted, they can be relocated.</p>
[20151218-2]	<p>Question – Drawing # SE1.L01b: The intercom labeled L0093 is noted as a new location requiring 120VAC power. Where is the power source? Will new trenching be required for power and communications to this new location? Please provide distances of cable and trenching.</p> <p>Answer – Yes. Coordination with the District is required to determine the best location suited to meet the conditions for the installation of this particular station.</p>
[20151218-3]	<p>Question – Drawings General: There are some conduit paths shown on the drawings. These paths do not connect all of the intercom stations to the PoE switches. Should bidders include the cost for new conduit to connect to the conduit paths shown?</p> <p>Answer – Yes.</p>
[20151218-4]	<p>Question – Drawings General: There are some conduit paths shown on the drawings. Do these conduits have sufficient capacity for the new cables required by this project?</p> <p>Answer – This is unknown. Please refer to Specification 280001 Part 1 - General 1.01 project intent, E, 2, a. For the sake of the bid it is assumed some conduit may be reused.</p>
[20151218-5]	<p>Question – Drawings General: Are as-built drawings available for the existing emergency phone system?</p>

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	<p>Answer – The conduit pathing shown in the bid documents reflect the as-built conditions provided by the District. It should be noted that not all of the campuses had as-builts.</p>
[20151218-6]	<p>Question – Bid response forms, Exhibit 5 – Bid Response Spreadsheet Workbook Instructions, Paragraph 7 page 10: The instructions state the Bid Response Spreadsheet shall be provided in electronic format via email or on a CD. Is this due the same time as the bid? Please provide the email address for electronic submittal.</p> <p>Answer – Yes. It can be Emailed to Seraphine Nzomo, to whom you emailed your RFI.</p>
[20151218-7]	<p>Question – Exhibit 2 Pricing, Section 280001, Item 1.01, C., Page 2: Please provide estimated cable distances for bidding purposes of the three (3) wall mounted interior stations to be replaced at the Berkeley campus.</p> <p>Answer – This information is unknown.</p>
[20151218-8]	<p>Question – Exhibit 2 Pricing, Section 285031, Item 2.01.B, Page 4: Item B states that All existing Code Blue steel enclosures are to be replaced with new Talk-A-Phone enclosures. Item 2. Interior Wall enclosures are based on the ETP-SMH style enclosure. The Wall Mount images do not match the listed part number. Drawing appears to be ETP-WME but the model listed is ETP-SMH please clarify.</p> <p>Answer – Per the Specification section listed in your question, there are two different types of wall mount enclosures. An interior wall mount, and an exterior wall mount. The interior wall mount is the ETP-SMH. The exterior wall mount is the ETP-WM series.</p>
[20151218-9]	<p>Question – Exhibit 2 Pricing, Section 285031, Item 2.01, E, Page 4: Item E states that all Emergency call stations are to have a built-in amplifier adequate to be used for emergency broadcast and announcements. The stations are to automatically have one (1) listen volume that is configurable, and another volume for broadcast volume. The Turbine TCIS-2VOIP Phone does not provide two (2) separate volumes, one for communications and one for broadcast announcements. Please clarify.</p> <p>Answer – The Turbine TCIS-2VOIP does provide this function. The function is called volume override. It requires programming that initiates the emergency level priority volume override.</p>
[20151218-10]	<p>Question – Exhibit 2 Pricing, Section 285031, Item 2.02, A, Page 4. In Spare Parts, A., it states Include five (5) spare emergency call stations. How should the five (5) spare emergency call stations be divided between the three (3) types of call stations?</p> <p>Answer – This is the emergency call station itself, not the steel enclosure. There is only one type of call station.</p>
[20151218-11]	<p>Question – Exhibit 2 Pricing, Section 280001 items 1.06 and 1.08 pages 4 and 5: In</p>

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the Exhibit 2 pricing document, Items 1.06 Quality Assurance, B. and 1.08 Submittals, A reference items to be provided at the time of bid submission. Are we to include these items as part of our proposal response in addition to items 1 through 7 listed in the RFP section III, Page 9 of 10? Please clarify

Answer – District documents take precedence over other specifications.
