	Co-Req	linked
Setup level	At the Course level: i.e. MATH 213: Co-Requisite MATH 13	At the Class level, i.e. MATH 213, Spring 2019, class # 24082: <i>Student must enroll in Both Math 13 (21112) and Math 213 (24082) at the SAME TIME to avoid enrollment requisite error.</i>
Count of setup	One time	Each term for each class required to be linked
Timeline for setup	One week before priority registration begins	One month before priority registration begins
Faculty assignment	N/A	Faculty must be assigned to the linked classes before the setup
Enrollment options	N/A	Students don't have an option to choose the support class that fits in their schedule
Cancelation	N/A	If there is a need to cancel one of the linked classes, they must be unlinked first
