Opportunities that fit your schedule:

Career Awareness

Build awareness of your careers and connect the role of post-secondary education. Opportunities include:

- Mentoring (1 semester+)
- Workplace Tours (60 to 90 minutes)
- Guest Speaker (1 hour)
- Career Fair (1 day)

Career Exploration

Help students to identify interests and match them to various career options. Opportunities include:

- Informational Interview (1 hour)
- Job Shadow (2 to 4 hours)
- Industry Exploration Tour (2 hours+)

Career Preparation & Training

Provide practical experience that develops knowledge and skills necessary for success in careers. Opportunities include:

- Mock Interview (15 minutes)
- Work Experience (length varies)
- Apprenticeships (1 semester+)
