PILOT OBJECTIVES:

1. Provide Early College Credit options for WCCUSD students
2. Align CTE and Career Pathway Curriculum and Programs
3. Increase teacher/faculty communication around curriculum and pathway activities
4. Enhance equity and access for potential CCC students

DUAL ENROLLMENT

Process

- HS teacher and CC faculty identify a college course that best fits pathway sequence and promotes college readiness
- Courses approved by both HS District and College District Boards (College & Career Access Pathways Partnership Agreements, AB288)
- HS students apply, register, enroll complete special admit form (supported by outreach, counseling & Workforce Development)
- Using the college course outline! The course is taught on HS campus by CCC Adjunct “Gratis” faculty (HS teacher or counselor that meets CC minimum qualifications) or CCC faculty that has a high school teaching credential
- Students simultaneously receive HS and College Credit (3 CC Credits = 10 HS credits)
- Courses offered are No Fee, Credit Bearing courses (students have no fees)

DUAL ENROLLMENT

Pros

- Allows student early opportunity to obtain college credit
- Courses are aligned with HS Pathway
- Increases FTES for college
- Increased likelihood student will enroll at CCC

Cons

- Poor performance can impact long term college G.P.A. & Financial Aid
- Students do not get “full campus” exposure

WCCUSD 2016 -17 PILOT

The Process

- CCC and WCCUSD Faculty met monthly for 7 months
- Reviewed curriculum and determined college courses that would introduce students to college program and were courses in which HS students were likely to be successful
- 4CD Administrators developed College and Career Access Pathways (CCAP) agreement
- HS Counselors and Assistant Principals trained in Application and Enrollment process
- Each HS has a dedicated counselor to support Dual Enrollment courses
- CCC “gratis” faculty participate in intensive Summer PD
