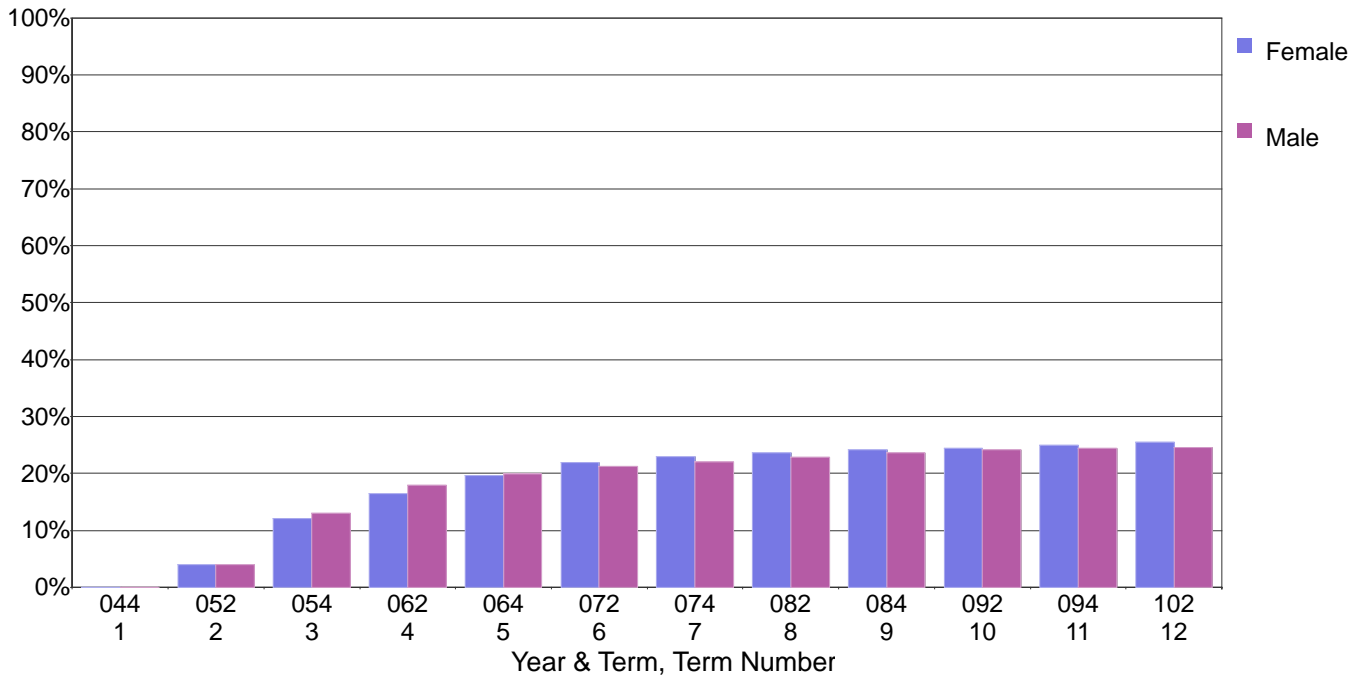

A College Level Unit is defined as units earned (i.e., with a grade of D or better) in a class that does not have a Basic Skills flag of B (basic skills) or P (pre-collegiate).
