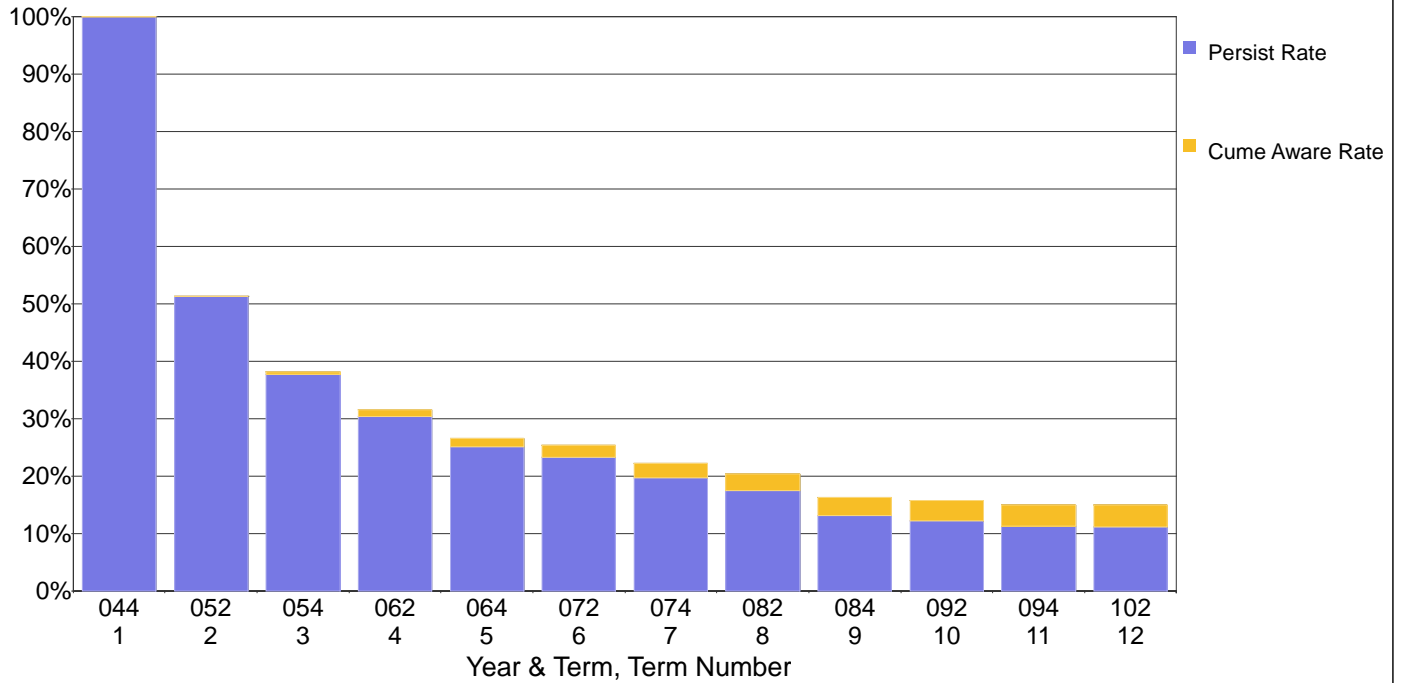

Full Part Status refers to the full-time or part-time status of students during their first term. A full-time student is defined as having earned 12 or more units.
