

FIVE STEP (Campus Computing Lifecycle Methodology) PROCESS

The Campus Computing Lifecycle Methodology (CCLM) quarterly process was created to equitably respond to all AVC campus constituent group requirements by:

- 1) assessing their needs,
- 2) consolidating/estimating their scope of work,
- 3) prioritizing,
- 4) submitting requests to Strategic Planning and Budget Committee (SPBC) for funding, and
- 5) scheduling/implementing the requests.

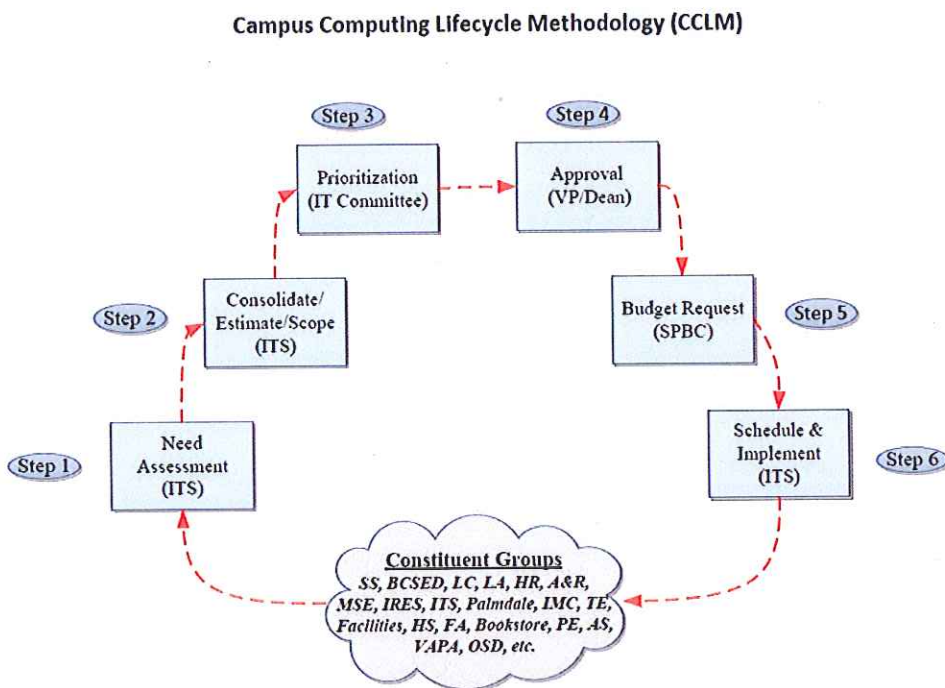


Chart 1: Campus Computing Lifecycle Methodology
