The group started by analyzing the matrix created by Tina but will be using a simplified matrix that will identify the mandates, current college status and responsible staff that will assist to comply with the mandates.

Priority registration is mandated for new students who have completed orientation, assessment and Counseling, an appeal process needs to be available to students.

Task #1 task – Each college reported on the status of orientation

Non-exempt students – core services

Laney-online orientation, ESL, live orientation, COUN200

BCC – live orientation with groups, both simplified and extended

Merritt – live extended orientation

COA – COUN 200, 6 sections and runs into the term, online orientation available.

Assessment is first, then 200A. They are working on curriculum for assessment prep and COUN 200B. After assessment students are referred to counseling then to 200A and B

There was a discussion on how to track ed plans? Some options are the PeopleSoft module, Credentials, and a program than Steve Pantel presented at a previous meeting. Both abbreviated and full plans should be tracked and this is critical to complying with the mandates. Funding of a comprehensive and abbreviated student plans will be funded differently so it is essential that staff know how to enter the correct codes is SARS.

There was some confusion about whether or not all four campuses would be offering the same options for the core services for new and non-exempt students. Mary thought it had been decided that all campuses would be offering COUN 200A but May stated that BCC has a different First Year Experience program.
