

BOARD POLICY 3820 GIFTS

The Board shall consider all gifts, donations, and requests made to the District. The Board reserves the right to refuse to accept any gift which does not contribute toward the goals of the District, or the ownership of which would have the potential to delegate resources to the District.

The District shall assume no responsibility for appraising the value of gifts made to the District.

Acceptance of a gift shall not be considered endorsement by the District of a product, Enterprise, or entity.

In no event shall the District accept a donation from any donor who engages in practices or policies which discriminate against any person on the basis of nationality, religion, age, gender, gender identity, gender expression, race or ethnicity, medical condition, genetic information, Ancestry, sexual orientation, marital status, military or veteran status, or physical or mental disability, or when the stated purposes of the donation are to facilitate such discrimination in providing educational opportunity.

The District will consult with counsel if a donor wishes to make a donation of a scholarship that will be tailored to help historically underrepresented groups. The district will not accept a donation from a donor when the stated purpose of the donation is to facilitate discrimination on the basis of nationality, religion, age, gender, gender identity, gender expression, race or ethnicity, medical condition, genetic information, ancestry, sexual orientation, marital status, or physical or mental disability.
